Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine de Laulan-France **£18.50**
A fine, award winning sauvignon blanc from a small producer in Cotes de Duras. Excellent fruity and zingy crispness prevail, displaying all the proper gooseberry and asparagus characteristics of this variety.

Chardonnay, Chibet, Les Vignerons d,Ambrosia-France **£18.50**
Unoaked chardonnay with a delicate buttery nose and a silky smooth, fruity finish. Inviting aromas of pear and fresh citrus flavours further enhance this very attractively presented white.

Chenin Blanc, Hutton Ridge-South Africa **£18.50**
This wine shows good flinty structure and has developed a delicious note followed by a fresh citrus flavour and an excellent follow through.

Albarino, Rias Baixas, Galicia-Spain **£31.50**
From Galicia in North West Spain, the coolest and wettest part, this crisp white has a lemon, fruity dry flavour with mouth-watering acidity. Excellent seafood wine.

Muscadet Sevre et Maine "sur lie", Los Rietelieres Loire-France £23.50
Clean, crisp fruit is immediately apparent on the primary palate and due to the ripeness of the grape at harvest time the normal acidic style has been replaced by soft, appealing fruit. Dry and yet full flavoured.

Verdicchio, Classico dei Castelli di Jesi Marche-Italy £23.50
Verdicchio is a unique, nutty grape from the Italian Adriatic coast. A classic, "International Wine Challenge" award winner.

Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay, Marlborough-New Zealand £80.50
Mouth watering aromas of passion fruit and lemongrass led by a hint of spiciness. The palate has exceptional richness, with ripe gooseberry and a hint of fennel leading to a powerful finish.

Pinot Grigio, Zenato, Veneto-Italy £29.50
Straw yellow in color with greenish highlights, and a delicate bouquet. This is a wine to be enjoyed young when one can best appreciate its zesty fruitiness. This versatile Pinot Grigio is a great choice for any occasion, but ideal with hors d'ouevres, soups and fish.

Wild Boar White, Chateau Routas Provence-France £26.50
This fragrant and crisp Provençal white blend is sure to refresh and delight. Great alternative to Chardonnay. Enjoy on its own, as an aperitif, or with shellfish, fish, poultry and vegetables.

Gavi, Dezzani, Costa Mezzano, Piedmont-Italy £33.50
Produced from 100% Cortese grapes that are manually harvested and vinified at controlled temperatures in stainless steel tanks. The Dezzani Gavi DOCG has ripe peach and almond fruit on the nose with a full persistent and balanced taste.

Sauvignon Blanc, Seifried Estate, Nelson-New Zealand £28.50
Fresh gooseberry and herbal aromas are followed by a zesty, tropical fruit palate. Natural acidity cuts through the wine with bright, steely nettle notes. This is a truly vibrant New Zealand sauvignon.

Sancerre Premier Cuvee, Guy Saget, Loire-France £32.50
A "gun flint" bouquet and an almost pale green colour. It has a delicious spicy flavour and is the perfect accompaniment to shellfish and seafood. A favourite of Parisians.

Viognier, Trivento, Mendoza-Argentina £22.50
Delicate fruit with a nuance of peach and then the flavour develops with delicious apricot kernels and a long spicy finish.

Chablis, Gerard Tremblay, Burgundy-France £31.50
If you love traditional steely Chablis then this is for you. Very mineral in style & not too aggressive, with trademark oyster-shell aromas, on the palate there is a further ripeness and secondary hints of mushroom, leaf and honey. Pair with oysters, sole, scallops and sea bass.

Pouilly Fuisse, Loron Maconnais-France £32.50
This truly great white wine is from the vineyards of the twin villages of Pouilly and Fuisse in the Maconnais Region. It is a Chardonnay that combines honeyed peachy richness with a citrus freshness.

Rioja Blanco, Marques de Caceres-Spain £29.50
A rich, dry white wine from the heart of Rioja, using viura grapes to produce one of the world's best-selling white riojas. Bright pale straw colour with metallic highlights. On the nose fresh notes of grapefruit and pears come through with a depth of minerals, resulting in a pleasant complexity.

Sauvignon Blanc, Franschoek-South Africa £23.50
Classic sauvignon blanc with tropical fruit, white pear and grapefruit aromas which follow through onto the palate and a crisp, clean finish. A wine of great finesse and elegance.

Pouilly Fume, Guy Saget, Loire-France £39.50
A pleasant medium-bodied and lightly earthy-grassy Sauvignon Blanc. One that seems to have picked up generous flavours of grapefruit sorbet. It also has a smoky quality as the word "fume" suggests.

Chablis 1er Cru "Vaillons", Domaine Long Depaquit-France £49.50
This elegant, flinty, mineral-laced wine is from the famed 1er Cru vineyard of Vaillons which sets the example for all its neighbours. A deep, nutty bouquet with hints of oak and a good depth of clean, dry fruit

Meursault Charmes 1er Cru, Domaine Millot, Burgundy-France £90.50
This wine has a fine straw gold colour with a soft, yet opulent, nose full of candied chardonnay fruit. On the palate it is regal with long, lingering flavours.

Chateauneuf du Pape Blanc, Chateau Mont-Redon, Rhone-France £41.50
From a traditional red wine area comes this unusual and fascinating white. Clean fruit with slightly honeyed notes arise along with substance and style. A fine alternative for white Burgundy drinkers.

Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru "Morgeots", Albert Bichot-France £85.50
A truly elegant wine with flavours of greengages and peach to start. Then, mellow and mouth filling limestone and lime zest with fine acidity wash over your tastebuds refreshing and invigorating.

Chardonnay Reserva, Terrazas de los Andes-Argentina £35.50

After the initial waft of ripened fruit, notes of apricot nectar, passion fruit, mango and pineapple are revealed. There are also light notes of toasted vanilla and caramel as a result of the barrel aging. Can be enjoyed with fish, seafood, pates and cheeses.

Three Variety Grape, Brown Brothers, Everton-Australia £23.50

Juicy and dry with a refreshingly crisp finish, each variety contributes to complete the wine: Chardonnay gives body, weight and length, the Sauvignon lifts the fruit and the Pinot Grigio adds structure. An all-round, excellent wine.

Semillon/Sauvignon, Cape Mentelle, Margaret River-Australia £32.50

Heady aromas of passionfruit, orange blossom, ripe lemons and notes of tarragon mingle with a waft of vanilla derived from barrel fermentation. The palate is creamy and textural, with vibrant, flamboyant citrus flavours that finish crisp and clean.

Rose

White Zinfandel, Kissing Tree, California-U.S.A. £20.00

A luscious Zinfandel Rosé from the warm, tree lined vineyards of California, bursting with ripe aromas of wild strawberries and exotic fruits. This bouquet follows through to the taste and is balanced with a refreshing, clean and lengthy finish

Pinot Grigio Rose, Ancora-Italy £25.00

Wonderfully easy-drinking Pinot Grigio rose. A dry, fresh and fruity rose with delicate aromas of red berries. Crisp and lively on the palate with good intensity of ripe berry and red cherry fruit.

Pinotage Rose, Stellenbosch Delheim-South Africa £25.50

This hand harvested wine is one of only a few made worldwide from grapes grown specifically for rose production. Radiant hues of pink with layers of strawberry and raspberry lingering to a crisp finish. Simply fantastic.

Red

Cabernet Sauvignon, Chibet, Les Vignerons d'Ambrosia-France £18.50

Enhancing aromas of black cherry and blueberry prevail in this medium bodied, fruity red. Good soft balanced structure for a cabernet from the South of France with supple tannins.

Artazuri Tinto D.O. Navarra-Spain £18.50

Made from garnacha, this wine is textbook Navarra with it's deep red colour, hints of bramble and spice on the nose and silky, mouth-watering, soft berry flavours.

Shiraz, Peter Lehmann Barossa-Australia £20.50

Everything you would expect from a good Aussie shiraz. Rich and spicy with excellent, up-front dark berry fruit, in a soft, easy drinking style.

Malbec Reserva, Trivento, Mendoza-Argentina £27.50

The bouquet is light with delicate fruit notes. Dry, cherry stone flavours and tannic balance blend to a finish of good length.

Pinotage, False Bay Stellenbosch-South Africa £22.50

Ripe cherry and tropical fruit on the nose with sweet and spicy flavours on the palate. A well balanced wine with an elegant mouth feel that finishes well. Delicious with ripe cheeses or char grilled meat.

Pinot Noir, Bourgogne, Bichot Burgundy-France £28.50

From the house of Bichot, this basic Burgundy has a light fruity flavour from older wines in a dry style with a tannic grip to finish.

Zinfandel, Wente, California-U.S.A. £22.50

This Zinfandel is bursting with the spicy aromas and flavours of raspberry and black pepper that typify this quintessential Californian varietal. With a full tannic backbone, this full-bodied Zinfandel is best paired with grilled meats, spicy pasta sauces and cheeses.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Franschoek-South Africa £23.50

Packed with fruit and slightly oaked, these hand picked grapes are destalked before maturation. This gives the wine an innate complexity before entering into French oak barrels for 12 months.

Wente's Hayes Ranch Merlot-2006 California £27.50

Dark Deep red coloured, the nose has a faintly herbal quality, with plenty of raspberry and plum fruit. The palate is structured and elegant, yet has a gentle, amiable personality, with ripe plummy fruit, hints of spice and ripe tannins.

Rioja, Paternina-Spain £26.50

From one of the oldest and most innovative bodegas in Rioja, this gold medal award winning wine is top class. The colour is cherry red with purple overtones. The wine has intense aromas with ripe red fruit characters and some elements of creamy, toasted oak.

Merlot, Cousino Macul, Antiguas Reserve, Santiago-Chile £27.00

The merlot grape seldom produces of its best outside its native Bordeaux, but here we have the full, velvety, bramble flavour and attractive aroma which signify a fine wine from this noble grape.

Cabernet Merlot, Cape Mentelle, Margaret river-Australia £40.50

An initial burst of sweet fruit and cassis leads into a rich palate of licorice and dark chocolate with savoury black bean and cedar characters. The tannins are dusty and add great length.

Cotes de Rhone, Heritiers Plantin, Chateau Mont-Redon-France £27.50

An intense colour with a rich, fruity nose. This Rhone wine has excellent structure with full, soft tannins. The palate is a wealth of spicy fruit.

Amarone Costasera Classico, Masi-Italy £70.50

This is a limited production wine, obtained from specially selected grapes where the bunches are picked and allowed to partially dry on wooden frames. It is a dry, generous wine with intense aromas and a harmonious soft flavour. Aging for three years in oak barrels gives this wine a smokey undertone.

Chianti Classico D.O.C.G. Rocca di Castagnoli-Italy £29.50

From an outstanding producer comes a world famous wine. On the nose hints of fresh cherries and in the mouth, the classic almond finish we have grown to love.

Valdubon Roble, Bodegas Valdubon, Ribera del Duero-Spain £41.50

This "roble"(a fine aged wine) shows, after three years, a deep bouquet with a hint of tar and then a soft, rich flavour touched with figs and tobacco and finishing fresh and spicy.

Fleuri, Chateau de Fleuri, Beaujolais-France £29.50

One of the great individual Crus or special villages(own A.C.)-here bottled by the owner. This is a plump, fresh, elegant wine bursting with fruit and even sensual appeal.

Chateau Lamothe Bergeron, A.C. Haut Medoc, Bordeaux-France £53.00

An excellent, hot vintage enabled claret with real depth of flavour. This trusty favourite has come up trumps with deep grape and cedar elements in its bouquet and a complex dry flavour with satisfying length.

Grenache, Yalumba Barossa Bush Vine-Australia £30.00

This is an outstanding, intense and beautifully crafted Grenache. A wine that opens with bright red fruits and spices with hints of violets and roses, plus some savoury complexity. On the palate, it shows richness and ripeness with layers of red and blueberry fruits.

Nuits St. George 1er Cru, Albert Bichot, Burgundy-France £70.50

From a vintage expressing silky and elegant pinot noir wines, this example is discreetly powerful, crisp and assertive, with underlying tannins showing a firm handshake. Confident and long with a satisfying finish. Very refined.

Pinot Noir, Seifried-New Zealand £30.00

A savoury number with plummy, strawberry notes. Subtle and elegant spicy oak complements the mushroom, coffee and bramble fruit palate. Well proportioned, supple tannins support the palate beautifully.

La Croix Marechal, Grand Cru Saint Emilion, Bordeaux-France £65.50

A wine full of soft, ripe blackberry fruit with good structure. A claret which will age well although it is definitely approachable now. Real class.

Malbec Reserva, Terrazas Andes-Argentina £33.00

Extremely fruity, black cherries with vanilla notes. A regal stature with a deep purple hue. One of Moet Hennesy's vineyards producing wine using all their expertise.

Rioja Reserva, Marques de Caceres-Spain £41.50

An unctuous wine with aromas of spicy bilberry jelly. Complex and rich. A superb example from the best known wine producing region of Spain. Ideal with steak and venison.

Valpolicella Ripassa, Zenato-Italy £45.00

The "Ripassa" wine is a deep ruby red colour with a complex nose of dried fruit, liquorice and intermixed with wood smoke. The taste is fleshy, rich and medium to full bodied, with dark cherry fruit, fresh tannins and good length.

Chateaunuef du Pape, Chateau Mont-Redon, Rhone-France £46.00

The largest estate of this Appellation and claimed by many, with good cause, to be the best. All grapes are hand picked. The opulent fruit aromas are enhanced with spice and smoky notes which evolve into a rounded delicate bouquet.

Pinot Noir, Cloudy Bay-New Zealand £60.50

An earthy wine with liquorice notes and hints of cherries and plums. An excellent, well balanced red wine with large character for a pinot noir.

Rioja Gran Reserva, Marques de Caceres-Spain £60.50

Intense, dark cherry red in colour with complex aromas of mature fruit and a touch of spice followed by a fabulous full bodied fruit on the palate. Elegance by the bottle.

Moulin d'Angludet, Margaux, Bordeaux-France £80.50

An attractive aroma of crushed blackcurrant and bramble comes through on the palate. Firm and well structured.
